# 9-10 PASS SNOWSPORTS PROGRAM 2019

A Snowsports program has been organised as part of the 'Participating with safety' and 'Event management' modules of the year 9 and year 10 PASS course.

The program will cater for beginners as well as those students who have had previous snow experience. All students attending the program must participate in the pre-program safety lessons to familiarise themselves with the safety procedures on the snow. The professional two-hour lesson provided each day on the snow is another important safety aspect of the snowsports program.

## PROGRAM DATES:

**Tuesday 27 August** (departing school at 11.30pm and travelling through the night, arriving at Bungarra early Wednesday morning) through to **Friday 30 August 2019**

- 3 days SKI hire (skis/stocks/boots) + helmet included in package.

# TRANSPORT:

- Transport provided in a 57 seater coach. The coach will collect us from sch ool at

school at the completion of the program.
