# 2022 HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS CARNIVAL – YEARS 7-12

The 800m, 1500m and triple jump events will commence at 8am. Any student wishing to enter these events must register with Mrs Mazzieri by the Friday prior to the carnival, and will be required to make their own way to the venue to compete at 8am. Parents are welcome to stay and watch their child participate on the day.

Javelin will be run at school NOT at the carnival for all age groups –Date to be advised.

We strongly recommended 30+ sunscreen and a protective hat or something warm and dry to wear depending on the weather. In the advent of wet weather you are to come to school prepared for the carnival as it is most unlikely to be cancelled unless dangerous electrical storms are predicted.

**Canteen facilities** will be available at the venue, however students are advised to bring their own food and drink.

It is understood as this is a compulsory day that students will attend the carnival.
