Year 6 high school taster week happening this week (year 10 on work experience). Year 10 work experience, thank you to parents working to make this happen. 110 students, all but one had something organised. Thank you to careers advisor for making huge effort to make this happen.

WOW charts for next term to come out early in the term.

Facebook page lots of things happening for primary, harder in high school. Working on a weekly update for what is coming up, a change to be used more than Sentral

High school uniform – Damian Bourke (relieving head teacher PDHPE) Issue of students not changing into sports uniform at school. Met with SRC, discussion with peers about policy.			
Y7-10 feedback was students were happy with current policy, small sample size and perhaps more diligent students ready to conform to the current rules.			
Policy states 3 strikes, many detentions requiring staffing from PDHPE staff. Students waiting for access to change rooms before they felt comfortable to change, missing a large chunk of the lesson time. Survey rolled out to Y7-10 students, 353 respondents- 84% NO not happy with current policy. Spread at results for reasons. Attempts at privacy have been vandalised.			
Push for physical activity at lunch/recess has been successful but results show uniform restrictive. 78% want to wear sports clothes on that day, 56% inclusive school uniform.			
Practical issues for Science/TAS for leather shoes. Issue with policing who is in which uniform, what is acceptable on which day. The sport uniform would be come acceptable uniform on any day.			
For a small school we have excellent sporting success and ability and want to participate.			
Request will potentially come from primary school parents to make the same change. Privilege when reaching high school. Year 11 and 12 don't change so high standard of uniform maintained in this stage.			
Addressing the unsocial behaviours that are leading to students feeling unsafe, will the behaviours still exist? Teachers need to be protected also, fine line.			
<b>ACTION</b> : Committee to discuss consultation moving forward (survey, etc) but supportive in general.			
<b>Fete</b> Positive community support for fete in general, proposed date wasn't locked in. Amphitheatre wont be completed in time for this proposed date and will limit access to oval, running track. Decision to delay 12 months to finish construction.	6.55PM		
Need to build momentum for Year 7 2025 as small numbers in year 5.			
Rides need to be booked 12 months in advance, risk assessments need principal discretion for sign off.			
People are potentially expecting some sort of event if this doesn't go ahead.
